Sub: **Verification of figures/data matched with CIS 3.1 software.**

With reference to aforementioned subject, it has been observed that the figures of pending old cases for more than 5, 10, 20 and 30 years which are sent to the High Court and other cases like petty offences, total number of cases are not being obtained/matched from CIS 3.1 software. Sometimes, the actual date of registration defers from the actual date exists in the physical record, resultantly, data received from district courts and the data which is on NJDG Portal does not match.

It is required that the report especially with regard to old cases, prepared by SW of district courts, must match with the "delay status" menu which is available in CIS 3.1 software. If any discrepancy is found, that must be rectified immediately.

As directed by Hon'ble the Acting Chief Justice, it must be compulsory for the Presiding Officer of the concerned court should certify/verify that the data is matched with the CIS software and ensure that the data is being sent correctly. In addition, the S.W. should only accept the monthly statement of each court where data is matched with the CIS software.

As directed, you are required to ensure that the information which is being sent to the High Court, be sent after due verification/comparing with CIS 3.1 software and you are required to put a note on the report that the information has been duly verified with the CIS software.

Further, you are also required to instruct the Presiding Officers of the all the courts and S.W. of District Courts that they should verify each and every information with C.I.S. 3.1 software with "delay status report", if any incorrect/false information is found then the verifying officer, concerned Presiding Officer and S.W. will be held responsible/liable.
