Sub: Compliance of directions/guidelines of Hon'ble Supreme Court regarding expeditious disposal of execution petitions.

Attention of all the Judicial Officers of the State of Madhya Pradesh is invited to the judgment dated 06.03.2025 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Civil Appeal Nos. 3640-3642 of 2025 (Arising out of SLP (C) Nos. 8490-8492 of 2020) titled as '*Periyammal (Dead) through LRS & Ors. Vrs. V. Rajamani & Anr. Etc.*' wherein, Hon'ble Supreme Court issued certain directions / guidelines regarding expeditious disposal of execution petitions.

In view of the pendency of execution petitions in the Courts in the State and in compliance thereof, Hon'ble the Chief Justice is pleased to, hereby, direct the Presiding Officers of all courts of District Judiciary to ensure that execution petitions/proceedings pending in various courts in the State including the new petitions filed hereafter, shall henceforth be decided and disposed of, without fail, within a period of 06 months otherwise the concerned Presiding Officer may be answerable to the High Court on its administrative side.

The directions / guidelines issued by Hon'ble Supreme Court in the aforesaid matter shall be scrupulously followed by the Presiding Officers of all courts of District Judiciary and any complacency or deviation thereof, may be viewed seriously.
