Respected Chief Justice,

As you are aware, 2nd October is observed as Swachh Bharat Diwas (SBD) to celebrate the Jan Andolan for Swachhata, as a tribute to Mahatma Gandhi on the day of his Jayanti. As a prelude to SBD-2024, the annual Swachhata Hi Sewa (SHS) fortnight is being jointly organized by Swachh Bharat Mission-Grameen and Urban (by the Departments of Drinking Water and Sanitation (DDWS) and Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA)) w.e.f. 14th September to 1st October, 2024. The theme of SHS-2024 is "Swabhav Swachhata-Sanskar Swachhata". As a part of this exercise, a series of activities like cleanliness drives, collection and disposal of waste, ensure clean toilets, No Black Spots etc., are proposed to be organised.

2. As the various court complexes within the country are public premises, visited by a large number of citizens, I would be grateful if a similar exercise could be undertaken in these locations, as well, during this period so as to broaden and strengthen the government's endeavour, as indicated above.

I would, therefore, request your kind support and leadership in encouraging the active participation of the High Court and the District & Sub-ordinate courts under your jurisdiction to participate enthusiastically in this national campaign "Swachhata Hi Sewa-2024 (SHS-2024)". I am also enclosing a brief on the suggested focus activities for this campaign alongwith this communication.

BACKGROUND AND SUGGESTED ACTIVITIES UNDER THE SHS CAMPAIGN-2024

Swachhata Hi Sewa (SHS) campaign is being celebrated from 17.09.2024 to 02.10.2024 under the joint aegis of Department of Drinking Water and Sanitation(DDWS) & Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) for undertaking shareman activities aiming to generate Jan Andolan through community participation; to provide impetus on implementation of SBM; to disseminate the important of a Samporna swachh village; to reinforce the concept of sanitation as everyone's business; and a prelude for the Swachh Bharat Diwas (2nd October) with national wide participation.

Theme of SHS-2024 is "**Swabhav Swachhata -Sanskaar Swachhata**" (स्वभाव स्वच्छता-संस्कार स्वच्छता). The campaign will be carried out in a whole of Government Approach with its emphasis on people's participation making "Sanitation everyone's business and will be jointly organized by SBM- Grameen and SBM Urban under the department of Drinking water and Sanitation(DDWS) and (MoHUA) and the main pillars of activities during campaign of SHS-2024 are as under:

Suggested activities under the SHS Campaign are as under:

- Collection and Disposal of Waste.
- Vender Sensitization for clean street food initiative.
- Waste to Art installation.
- Citizen engagement.
- Mass scale cleanliness drives.
- No Black Spots (neglected garbage points / Posing environmental health and hygiene risk).
- Ensure provision of clean and well- maintained public toilets within the court complex to enhance the overall cleanliness and convenience for staff, litigants and advocates
- Fortnight cleanliness plan with specific plan for 1st October, 2024 and 2nd October, 2024.
- Public awareness drives to be conducted for the campaign.
