The dates are liable to be changed in case of Administrative Exigencies with prior approval.
- 5. In cases of Administrative Exigencies, the Secretary of the Committee may request the available Senior Most Judge of the respective Committee, to assign a date for convening a meeting on any other unscheduled date in addition, so that urgent and important matters are not held-up for want of dates of the meeting.
