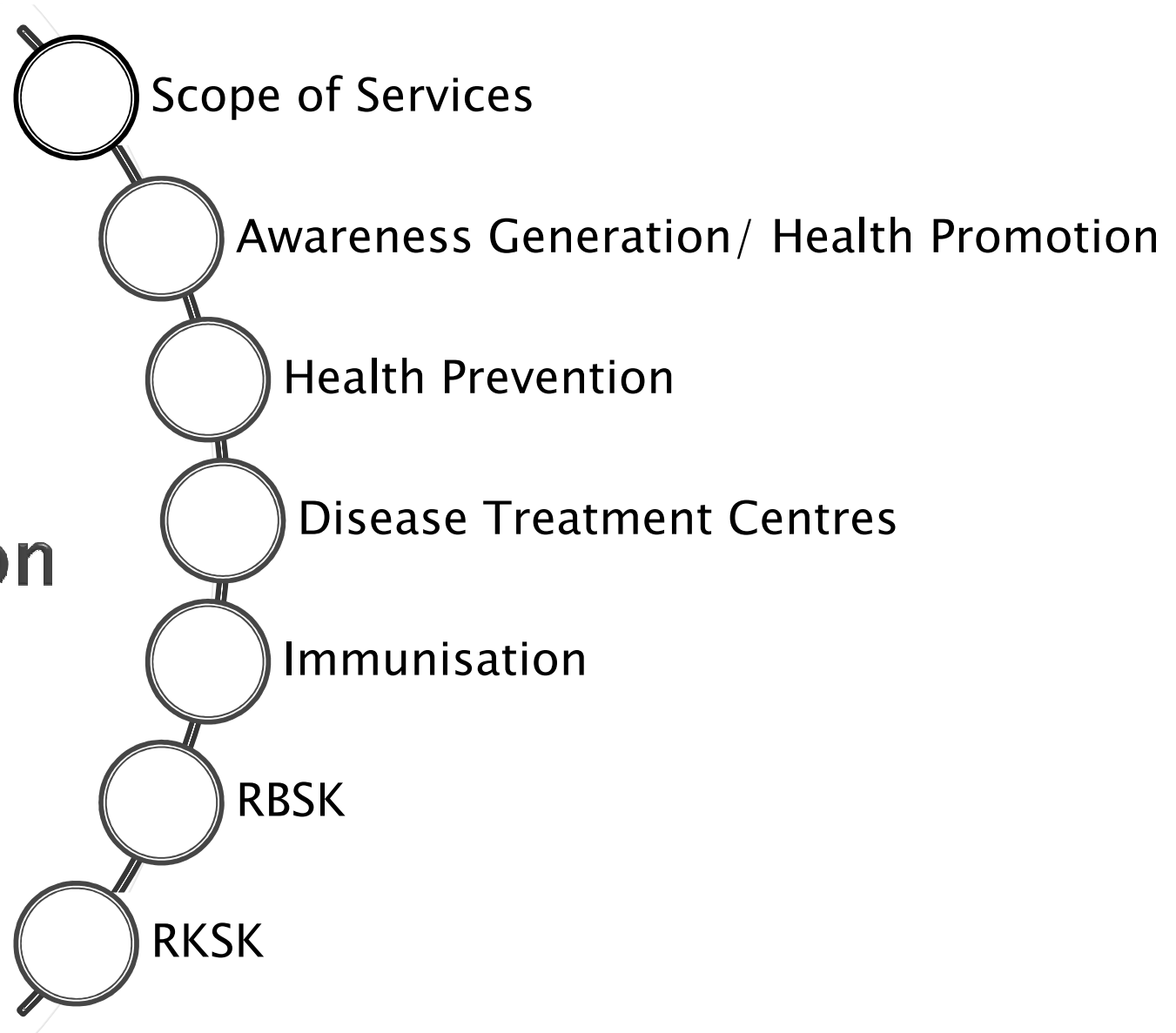

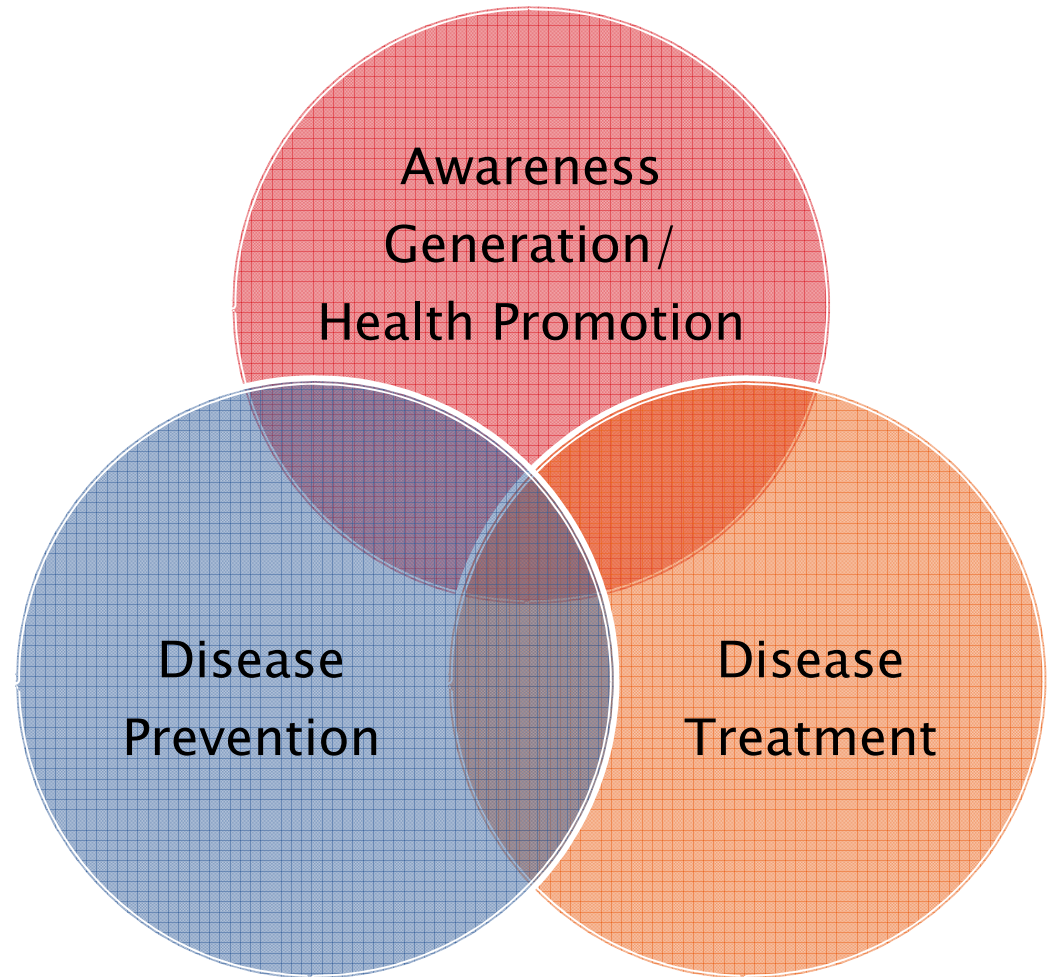
# Flow of Presentation

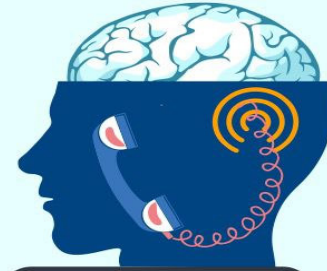

| 6 weeks            | OPV1, RVV1, fIPV1, PCV1, Penta1 |
| 10 weeks           | OPV2, RVV2, Penta2              |
| 14 weeks           | OPV3, RVV3, fIPV2, PCV2, Penta3 |
| 9 months           | fIPV3, MR1, PCVB                |
| 16-24 months       | OPVB, MR2, DPTB1                |
| 5 years            | DPTB2                           |
| 10 years           | Td1                             |
| 16 years           | Td2                             |
| Pregnant Women     | Td1, Td2 and Td Booster         |

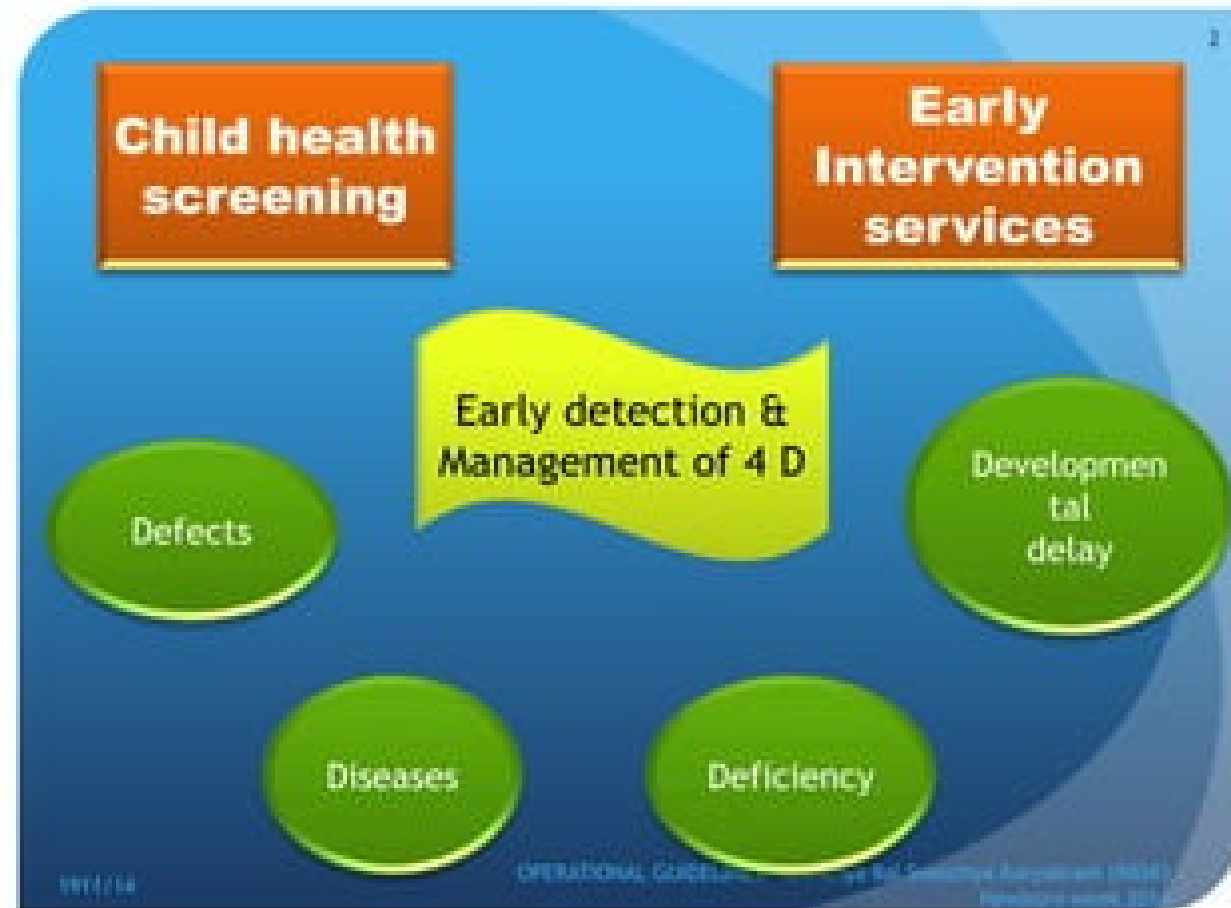

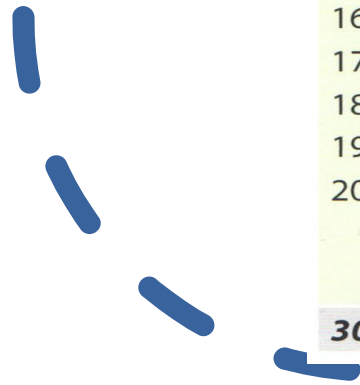

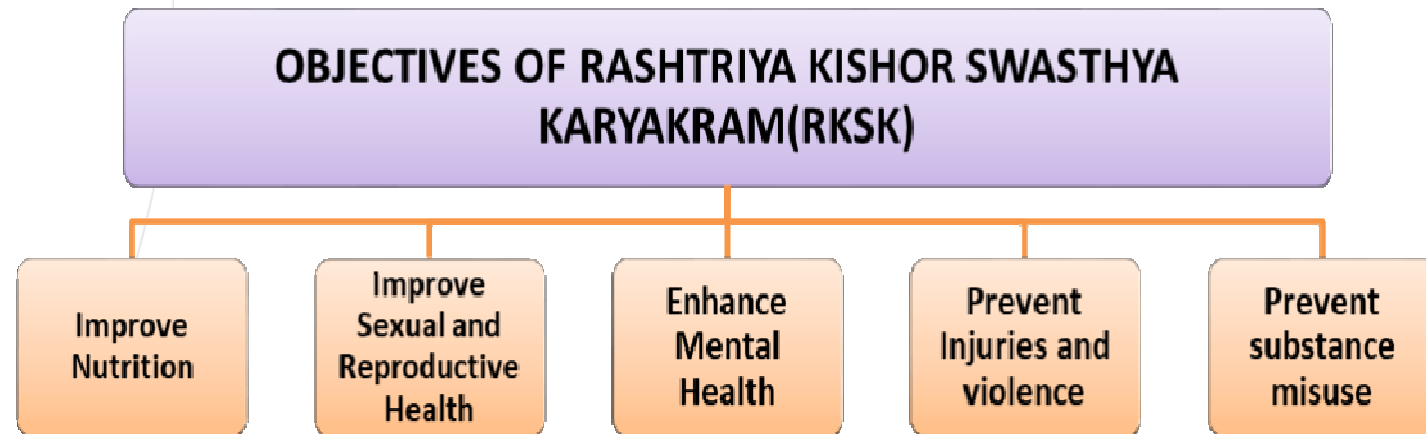
