Sub: A five day Course on 'Coordination among Police Department, Judiciary, Prison and FSL & Speedy Trial & Efficient Prosecution' organized by the S.V.P. National Police Academy, Hyderabad from September 08-12, 2025-Inviting nomination -reg.

A five day Course on 'Coordination among Police Department, Judiciary, Prison and FSL & Speedy Trial & Efficient Prosecution' is being organized by S.V.P. National Police Academy, Hyderabad from September 08-12, 2025 for officers of the rank of Addl. Superintendent of Police to Inspector General of Police and also for officers of equivalent ranks from Judiciary, FSL, Prison Department and Prosecution officers.

2. The objectives of the Course are:-

- a. To strengthen the capacity of all stake holders of CIS by identifying gaps and issues in co-ordination.
- b. Discuss/Brainstorm on proactive and innovative measures/case studies to improve co-ordination.
- c. Awareness of problems and issues faced by each other (agencies)
- d. General expectations from each other.
- e. Discuss required amendments in Substantive and Procedural Criminal laws for effective coordination among agencies.
- f. To discuss the required amendments for making procedural and substantive laws more simpler and speedy justice oriented, especially in the light of suggestions sought by Ministry of Home Affairs, from all the States, regarding amendments in Criminal Statutes.
- g. To encourage widespread awareness and understanding about the latest processes being incorporated in CIS system, integration of CIS and CCTNS and the latest initiatives being undertaken by E-Committee of Supreme Court.
- h. To apprise the officers of amendments required in procedural and substantive laws for making trials lesser cumbersome and speedy.
- i. To make Legal Aid, Plea Bargaining, Camp Courts, Alternative Dispute Resolutions a reality in criminal justice delivery system.
- j. Understanding the application of Pre Trial Conference, splitting of trial, stages mandatorily requiring the presence of accused and where it can be dispensed with.
- k. Discussing the best practices being followed in other States for speedy disposal of cases.
- l. Learning the effectiveness of usage of provisions regarding withdrawal of cases, by prosecution to reduce the pendency.
