**The nominated Judicial Officers are directed to observe following instructions :-**

- To keep themselves in readiness to attend the training programme, on respective dates, on receipt of further communication, either from the High Court of M.P., Jabalpur or from the LNJN National Institute of Criminology and Forensic Science, Delhi.
  - To apprise themselves with the information about their acceptance of nomination for the training programme available on the NICFS website [www.nicfs.nic.in](http://www.nicfs.nic.in) and proceed, accordingly. The list of nomination can be downloaded under link "Training" about 30 days prior to the Course. A second list, if needed, will be hosted by the Institute on website 15 days prior to Course.
  - **Nominated Judicial Officers must not proceed without acceptance of nomination.**
  - To arrange Board Diary in such a manner that no case is listed on the dates, on which they are directed to attend this programme. In case, cases have been fixed for the said dates, Summons should not be issued and if Summons are issued, then the parties should be informed about the change in dates.
