LOCATION

CDTI, Jaipur, Rajasthan is located at Vidhyadhar Nagar, Sector – 10. It is 1.5 Km. away from Soni Manipal Hospital, 4 Km. away from Rajasthan Police Academy and 8 Km. away from Jaipur Railway station.

CLIMATE

During the course, the temperature is expected to be in the range from 35 C to 40 C. The participants are advised to come prepared accordingly.

REPORTING:

ACCOMMODATION & MESSING:

UNIFORM & CLOTHING:
