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Objective of the Course as provided by the SVP National Police Academy, Hyderabad for enabling the participants of the Course

1. To understand the Genesis and ramifications of Crime against women in India and various aspects of trafficking of women.
2. To understand the desired response of the Criminal Justice System to the needs of the victims of this Crime and an insight into victim compensation scheme.
3. To understand the role played by NGOs in victim support with successful case studies.
4. To be able to effectively implement strategies for effective prosecution in investigation of cases pertaining to crime against women – Advanced Forensics in investigation of cases.
5. To understand the jurisprudence of women empowerment and domestic violence: role of Police in dealing with domestic violence – Toxic Masculinity/ Emotional abuse.
6. Investigation of Crime against women in Cyber space/ cyber bullying/ online stalking etc.
7. New age Crime against women – revenge attacks, acid attacks, suicides, etc.
