LOCATION

CDTI, Jaipur, Rajasthan is located at Dehmi Kalan, Near Manipal University, Ajmer Road, Jaipur-303007. Kindly search the location of CDTI Jaipur on Google Map.

CLIMATE

During the course, the temperature is expected to be in the range from 25 C to 30 C. The participants are advised to come prepared accordingly.

REPORTING:

Participants must reach CDTI, Jaipur at least one day in advance prior to the commencement of the course. Participants are advised to communicate their journey plan in advance through telephone 0141-2823100 and email (director.cdti-rj@gov.in) to CDTI Jaipur.

ACCOMMODATION & MESSING:

Hostel and mess facilities are available at Central Detective Training Institute, Dehmi Kalan Ajmer Road Jaipur. The hostel is situated in the campus of CDTI. The participants are advised not to bring their families while attending the course.

UNIFORM & CLOTHING:

The participants shall attend the course in civil dress with formal order. They may not wear T- shirts, jeans, sports shoes, chappals and sandals in the class room.
