From the record as made available to us, it appears that these writ appeals were dismissed for non-prosecution in terms of conditional order dated 19.08.2015. The circumstances in which application for restoration of writ appeal was posted before the learned Single Judge is not forthcoming. M.C.C. No.3626/2015 and M.C.C.No.3630 /2015 having been filed for restoration of writ appeals should have been placed for hearing before the Division Bench, as the Single Judge has no jurisdiction to entertain these writ appeals. Orders passed on M.C.C.No.3626/2015 and 3630/2015, to say the least, is without jurisdiction and suffers from the vice of *coram-non-judice*.

Accordingly, the same is **set aside** and instead M.C.C. No.3626/2015 and 3630/2015 are restored to the file to its original number and proceeded forthwith, by

consent.

The applicant must first remove all the office objections.

Office to ascertain whether any office objection covered by the conditional order dated 19.08.2015 is still to be removed by the applicant. That report be submitted on the next date.
