This is to mention that in light of Video conferencing and e-filing guidelines issued by M.P.High Court, the advocates who are seeking urgent hearing for their cases are doing e-filing through website of M.P.High Court.

For Indore Bench, it has been observed some learned advocates, while doing the e-filing through website of High Court are uploading the scanned PDF documents (petitions, loose documents, etc) of their cases after scanning or taking its picture from the mobile camera in gray scale or on color format. Due to this, the size of uploaded scanned documents is becoming very large and much time is being consumed at Presentation section in downloading it and doing further judicial process on it. Also since documents are being scanned by advocates with Gray Scale options, images of the scanned document is not fully or partially legible in many cases at High Court level which is causing inconvenience at High Court end. Also during the scrutiny of such cases defects may be applied by the Presentation Section staff.

Hence with a view to avoid all these inconvenience, all the learned advocates are hereby requested to kindly first check at their own level that the document they are going to scan and upload on High Court website are legible in actual sense and then the scanning of the legible documents needs to be done with a proper scanner preferably with Black and White option and not in Gray Scale. If the conditions demand the scanning of documents with the Cam Scanner of Mobile then it should be scanned preferably with Black and White option and PDF file should be uploaded on website not the images.
