Counsel for the petitioner submits that during the pendency of this petition NCTE has issued the communication dated 14<sup>th</sup> January, 2016. It is open to the petitioner to place that communication on record.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of that communication, petition can be disposed of on those terms.

Counsel for the respondents to take instructions in that behalf from the respondents.

Copy of that communication be made over to the counsel for the NCTE in the Court.

Counsel for the petitioner points out that there are other petitions raising identical issue filed before the Gwalior Bench of this Court being **W.P. No.11/2016** and

connected matters.

To avoid any conflict opinion and also multiplicity of proceedings and hearing, the Registry must take steps to transfer those cases to Principal Seat at Jabalpur - to be heard along with this case.

The Registry must also ascertain whether other cases involving identical question, are pending at Indore Bench - so that those cases also can be transferred and heard before one Court.
