FOR PROMOTION TO THE MADHYA PRADESH HIGHER JUDICIAL SERVICE, DISTRICT JUDGE (ENTRY LEVEL) THROUGH LIMITED COMPETITIVE EXAM-2020 AMONGST THE SENIOR CIVIL JUDGES (CLASS-I)

Last Date for Receiving Applications – 10-06-2020 (Wednesday) (Midnight-11:59PM) Date of Written Examination - 05-07-2020 (Sunday)

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Applications are invited for 06 vacant post in the cadre of Madhya Pradesh District Judge (Entry Level) through Limited Competitive Examination from amongst eligible Civil Judges (Senior Division) of State of Madhya Pradesh, in the pay scale of Rs. 51550-1230-58930-1380-63070 or as amended time to time.

Promotion to the post and conditions of service shall be strictly governed by the M.P. Higher Judicial Service (Recruitment and conditions of service) Rules 2017.

1. Eligibility:-

Only Civil Judges Class- I of Madhya Pradesh, who have completed five years of their service as Civil Judge (Senior Division) on the date of examination, will be eligible to apply.

The List of such eligible Civil Judges Class-I is available on the website of M.P. High Court (www.mphc.in).

2. Application:-

The eligible Civil Judges, desirous of appearing in the Examination, will have to submit his/her online application on the website of MP High Court (www.mphc.gov.in) or through E-mail, on or before the 10-06-2020.

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Procedure and Direction for submitting Application Form:-

Format of Application Form uploaded/published on the website of the M.P. High Court alongwith Advertisement & List of Eligible Judicial Officers/candidates.

The Eligible Civil Judge desirous to appear in this Examination will have to send an application in the given format **through E-mail** of Examination Cell (i.e. www.examcell@mphc.gov.in), which must have been received on or before 10.06.2020 (Midnight-11:59PM). Application Form received after aforesaid stipulated period/time shall not be entertained / considered on any ground whatsoever, it may be and shall stand rejected without assigning any reason and such representations received, if any, after declaration of the result, shall stand rejected without assigning any reason. The eligible candidates/ Civil Judges (Senior Division) if does not apply, shall be treated as not willing to appear in Exam.

3. Disqualifications:-

The candidate shall be treated disqualified and Departmental action may be initiated against him, if:-

- (i) He/she seeks, any favour in any form at any stage of the Examination, or attempts to do so. or
- (ii) Impersonation by or for the candidate, or
- (iii) Fabricate or submit any forged document in support of his or her candidature, or
- (iv) He/she conceals any material information or provides any false information at any stage of selection process, or
- (v) He/she uses or attempts to use, improper or illegal means to get permitted to appear in examination or enter in examination room/hall, or
- (vi) If he/ she creates any nuisance or extend threat or causes any physical or mental injury or misbehaves with any Officer or employee engaged to conduct exam during the process of objective or written examination. or
- (vii) He/she, disobeys any directions relating to examination including oral directions given by the invigilator or observer or any other Officer or employee engaged in conduction of Examination.

Moreover, Canvassing in any form will also be a disqualification. Similarly, any attempt on the part of a candidate to enlist support in respect of his/her candidature or selection/appointment through

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person of influence or officer (s) of Government/High Court will also disqualify him/her for appointment.

4. Travelling Expenses -

Travelling Expenses or allowances to the Civil Judge appearing in aforesaid examination, will be payable as per Rules in the same manner *i.e.* travelling on official duty.

5. Call Letter :-

Call letters shall be sent to the candidate's E-mail I.D. by the Examination Cell atleast 05 days prior to the date of Examination, candidate can download and printout the same.

Call letters shall be issued only to those candidates / Civil Judges Class-I who will submit their application within time and prescribed form.

6. Date, Time & Venue of Examination -

There will be an examination comprising of two Papers. Presently, the proposed date of examination is <u>05/07/2020 (Sunday)</u> and time will be:-

1 st Paper	Time $-10:00$ a.m. to $12:00$ p.m.
2 nd Paper	Time - 02:00 p.m. to 05:00 p.m.

The examination shall be held in High Court Campus, at Jabalpur under the control, supervision and guidance of Principal Registrar (Exam)/Registrar (Exam) or as directed by Hon'ble the Chief Justice.

Special Instructions regarding Covid-19 Pandemic:

It is imperative that special instructions, to be strictly followed by the all stake holders, be issued.

- (1) At the time of entry in examination centre each candidate shall submit a self Declaration Form that he/she is not Corona Positive as per his/her knowledge, this fact may be verified by the staff with the help of Arogya Setu App installed and at active mode in the mobile phone of candidates. He will be subjected to temperature testing at the time of entry in exam hall.
- (2) Candidates & staff must reach the examination centre well ahead of time to ensure staggered movement and smooth entry to avoid overcrowding.
- (3) During entry to and exit from the examination hall, candidates are advised to do so in a staggered manner to maintain social distancing norms.
- (4) Candidates must use face mask/cover and carry their own hand sanitizer. The use of gloves is optional.
- (5) Candidates are required to bring their own writing stationery and avoid sharing the same with other candidates.

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- (6) Candidates are required to carry their Admission Cards to the Examination hall.
- (7) Candidates need to strictly follow all the safety instructions at the examination centre.
- (8) Alongwith this all stake holders shall abide and follow the instructions/guidelines to be followed by citizens, issued by appropriate authority and any other instructions issued by Examination Cell in this regard.
- (9) Non-compliance of above directions may lead to rejection of candidature of delinquent candidate.

Note-	(1)	Current cases shall be based on JOTI Journal from last five years.
	(2)	Quoting of principle/ratio of a judicial pronouncement may enough and quoting of citation particulars will not carry any extra weightage but the quoting of wrong citation may be detrimental to the candidate.

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(3) An attempt to disclose the identity of candidate, would result of his/her disqualification.

8. Valuation of Question Papers :-

<u>1st Question Paper</u> – After examination, the valuation of 1st Paper shall be made by OMR Scanner with the help of the Registrar (I.T.) under supervision, control and guidance of Principal Registrar/registrar (Exam).

<u>2nd Question Paper</u> – Valuation of Answer Books of 2nd Question Paper shall be made by Central Valuation Method at Conference Hall or Examination Cell of M.P. High Court under the control and guidance of Principal Registrar/registrar (Exam). Hon'ble the Chairman of Examination—Cum-Selection & Appointment Committee or his nominee shall supervise the valuation.

9. Bench Mark: -

There shall be no Interview/Viva- Voce. However, past overall performance of candidate shall also be subject to consideration. For consideration of Past Performance, there shall be <u>50 marks on</u> the basis of Bench Mark of the Officer concerned, to be evaluate on following criteria, which shall be a forming part of the final result -

- Notes-1- Every candidate/ Judicial officer appearing in L. C. examination is required to submit one contested Civil Judgment and one contested Criminal case Judgment passed by him before the date of examination. Judgment of only those candidates will be evaluated/scrutinize who have/has secured at-least 50% marks (aggregate) of both Q.P-1 & 2.
 - 2- For computing marks of ACR's and Disposal of last five year, the following parameters shall be adopted-
 - (i) For each year ACR Grade-wise mark shall be as under -

In computing of disposal marks of last five year, disposal of last five years excluding the period where no Judicial work was assigned whereas the period of deputation shall be taken into account.

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- 3- To consider reputation and integrity, vigilance report of concern Judicial Officers shall be called from Vigilance Cell.
- 4- Mere passing the Limited Examination by the candidate will not create any right of promotion unless his past performance & reputation makes him suitable / fit for such promotion.

10. Minimum Marks.

A Candidate/Civil Judge, aspirant for promotion under Rule 5(1) (b) shall have to secure minimum 50% marks (including the Bench Mark) for being declared successful subject to merit and number of posts.

11. Result /Select List-

The result shall be prepared as early as possible. The result shall be put up before full Court of the High Court for its approval and after approval thereof, the final select list, shall be published on the website of the M.P. High Court.

12. Elimination/disposal of Used Examination Materials :-

The used Examination material shall be eliminated after expiry of One year from the date of declaration/publication of Final Select List.
