1. Application :-

Applications are invited for above mentioned vacant posts through this advertisement, the eligible Civil Judges Senior Division desirous to appear in Examination will have to submit online application on the website of MP High Court (www.mphc.gov.in), on or before **16.07.2021**.

The candidate who fails to submit application form within prescribed period shall be tantamount their non-willingness to appear in this exam.

Procedure for submitting Online Application Form :-

A link for filling the online application form will be provided to all eligible candidates via E-mail. By clicking on the provided link the

application form will get open, after filling of required information in the Application Form, candidate have to click on “browse” button to upload recent Color Photo and Signature (only in *jpeg* format). After filling the form candidate have to click on “Submit” Button for final submission, then candidates are advise to check the preview of Application Form, if all information is correct then click on “submit” button otherwise candidate can click on “reset” button to modify the information.

- Note:-**
1. Candidates are required to read all information carefully before final submission of Application Form there shall be no provision for correction after final submission.
 2. Candidates are advised to keep with him/her a printout of the finally submitted application/form.

2. Disqualifications :-

In any of the following cases, the Judicial Officer/candidate for afore-said examination shall be disqualified and/or Departmental action for misconduct may be initiated against him:-

- (i) If he or she takes or attempts to take any favour in any form at any stage of examination, or
- (ii) Impersonation by or for the candidate, or
- (iii) Making or submitting any forged document in support of his or her candidature, or
- (iv) If he or she conceals any material information or provides any false information at any stage of selection process, or
- (v) If he or she uses or attempts to use, improper or illegal means, either for purpose of being permitted to appear in examination or at any stage of examination in examination room/hall, or
- (vi) If he or she, during written examination harasses or threatens or causes physical injury to or misbehaves with, any Officer or employee engaged there, or
- (vii) If he or she, disobeys any directions relating to examination including oral directions by the invigilator or observer or any other Officer or employee engaged in conduction of examination.

Moreover, Canvassing in any form will also be tantamount to disqualification. Similarly, any attempt on the part of a candidate to enlist support for his candidature or selection/appointment, through persons of influence or officers of Government/High Court will also disqualify him for appointment.



3. Admit cards :-

Admit Cards shall be generated at about 05 days prior to the date of examination by MP High Court on its website (www.mphc.gov.in). Candidate(s) shall have to download and take print-out of their respective Admit Card(s). Admit Card shall be issued only to those candidates / Civil Judges (Senior Division) whose applications are received by High Court examination cell within prescribed time limit

4. Date, Time & Venue of Examination –

There will be an examination comprising of two Papers.

- Note-**
- (1) Current cases shall be based on JOTI Journal from last five years.
 - (2) Quoting of principle/ratio of a judicial pronouncement may enough and quoting of citation particulars will not carry any extra weightage but the quoting of wrong citation may be detrimental to the candidate.
 - (3) An attempt to disclose the identity of candidate, would result of his/her disqualification.

6. Objections & Finalization of Model Answers -

After completion of Examination, the proposed Model Answers/Keys intended to be used for result of OMR sheets, shall be uploaded/published on the website of the M.P. High Court for the purpose that if any candidate wishes to make any objection/clarification etc. regarding any proposed answer, he /she may submit their respective objection(s) in writing by mentioning his/her name duly signed clarification along-with self attested photo copies of source document(s)/proof, on the basis of which he/she has raised objection / clarification etc. to the Principal Registrar (Exam) M.P. High Court, Jabalpur, through E-mail (pregexamhcbp@mp.gov.in) within 03 days from the date of uploading/ publication of the proposed Model Answers/ Keys.

If no objection is received within prescribed time then proposed answers shall be treated as final for purpose of generation of result. After declaration of result, no representation regarding any objection/ clarification to model Answers / questions, shall be entertained for any ground(s) and shall stand rejected without assigning any reason.

7. Bench Mark: –

There shall be no Interview/Viva- Voce. However, past overall performance of candidate shall also be subject to consideration. For consideration of Past Performance, there shall be **50 marks on the basis of Bench Mark** of the Officer concerned, to be evaluate on following criteria, which shall be a forming part of the final result -

Notes- 1- Every candidate/ Judicial officer appearing in this examination is required to submit one contested Civil Judgment and one contested Criminal case Judgment passed by him before the date of examination. Judgment of only those candidates will be evaluated/scrutinize who have/has secured at-least 50% marks (aggregate) of both Q.P -1 & 2.

2- For computing marks of ACR's and Disposal of last five year, the following parameters shall be adopted-

(i) For each year ACR Grade-wise mark shall be as under -

Grade	A+ or A	B	C	D	E
Marks	4	3	2	1	0

(ii) For each year Disposal Grade-wise mark shall be as under

Per day average in units	9 or above	Very Good	Good	Average	Below average
Marks	4	3	2	1	0

In computing of disposal marks of last five year, disposal of last five years excluding the period where no Judicial work was assigned whereas the period of deputation shall be taken into account.

- 3- To consider reputation and integrity, vigilance report of concern Judicial Officers shall be called from Vigilance Cell.
- 4- Mere passing the Limited Examination by the candidate will not create any right of promotion unless his past performance & reputation makes him suitable / fit for such promotion.


8. Final Result

After completion of entire above-mentioned process of selection, the result shall be prepared as early as possible and published on the website of the M.P. High Court. A Candidate/Civil Judge, aspirant for promotion under Rule 5(1)(b) shall have to secure minimum 50% marks (including the Bench Mark) for being declared successful subject to merit and number of posts.

There shall be no provision of revaluation of answer-books and any application from any candidate for revaluation, if received, shall stand rejected without assigning any reason.

9. Special Instructions regarding Covid-19 Pandemic :-

All stake holders shall abide and follow the instructions/guidelines to be followed by citizens, issued by appropriate authority and any other instructions issued by Examination Cell in this regard. Non-compliance of above directions may lead to rejection of candidature of delinquent candidate.





10. Corrigendum: - At any time after the recruitment process has started if any Clarification, Modification *etc.* is required to be made on the part of High Court then it may be done by porting a corrigendum, on the official website of M.P High Court, which shall be deemed as sufficient notice to all candidates/ aspirants and no objection shall be entertained on the ground that candidate was having no information of such corrigendum.

11. R.T.I. - If any candidate applies under RTI and if rules permit then the desired information shall be made available, only to the candidate concerned, by the High Court of MP, subject to payment of prescribed fees only after declaration of Final Result & before expiry of a period of elimination of records.

12. Elimination/disposal of Used Examination Materials :-

The used Examination material shall be eliminated after expiry of One year from the date of declaration/publication of result.
