Note:-

1. Video Conferencing / Hybrid hearing facility is available to the Learned Advocates / Parties-in-person in High Court of Madhya Pradesh at Principal Seat Jabalpur and Benches at Indore & Gwalior. This facility may be availed through the link made available in daily / weekly Cause List of each Court.
2. A list of Final Hearing Cases will be issued for every Court. They shall be taken up on every Wednesday and Thursday from 2:30 P.M. On other working days, these cases shall be taken up after completion of the motion list.
3. Learned Advocates / Parties-in-person / Registered Clerks may file cases / applications / documents, etc. in physical form at the Presentation Centre / Filing Counters. In addition to this, the cases / applications / documents, etc. may also be dropped through Drop Boxes. Apart from it, cases / applications/ documents, etc. may also be filed through e-filing mode.
4. Mentioning for listing of fresh & pending Division Bench matter(s) only for the same day, will be entertained by the respective Division Benches as per Roster / Assignment.
5. Mentioning for listing of fresh Single Bench matter(s) only for the same day will be entertained by the available senior Single Bench, to whom the same nature of cases have been assigned as per Roster / Assignment.
6. Mentioning for listing of pending Single Bench matter(s) only for the same day will be entertained by the respective Single Bench as per Roster / Assignment.
7. Mentioning for listing of tied-up matters for the same day will be entertained by the tied-up Division / Single Bench. If, the tied-up Bench is not available, then Mentioning of such tied-up matters will be entertained by the available senior Division / Single Bench as the case may be.

8. If, DB-I / DB-II / DB-III / DB-IV is not available for any reason, Mentioning of the cases to be entertained by these Division Benches, will be entertained by the DB-II / DB-III / DB-IV & DB-III respectively. If any three Division Benches are not available, Mentioning of Division Bench matters will be entertained by the available Division Bench.
9. Mentioning of all other Cases will be done in physical form through Drop Box only. All such Mention Memos shall be dropped between 10:30 A.M. to 11:30 A.M. in the Drop Box placed near the office of Registrar (Judicial-II).
10. Learned Advocates / Parties-in-person are requested to submit Mention Memos only in those cases, which are of real urgency. All such Mention Memos shall be submitted by assigning brief, specific & pointed reasons, which highlight the urgency.
11. The computer generated date as authenticated by the Principal Registrar / Registrar (Judicial) of Mention Memo matters, may be treated as Court given date and the matter may be listed on that date.
12. No Mention Memo will be entertained in those cases, in which fixed date has been given by a Judicial order.
13. The information about Mentioning of the Case only for the same day shall be given to the opposite party/parties at least one day in advance through copy of Mention Memo, which will be duly acknowledged in writing by the opposite party/parties. The opposite party/parties may or may not give the consent for the Mentioning of such Case. Such Mentioning, in which consent has been given or not, will be entertained by the concerned Bench as per Roster / Assignment.
14. If any party/parties seek(s) adjournment in any Case, such party/parties shall give information regarding seeking adjournment at least one day in advance through attached format, which will be duly acknowledged in writing by the opposite party/parties. The opposite party/parties may or may not give the consent for adjournment of the Case. Such request for seeking adjournment will be entertained by the respective Benches.

15. If any Hon'ble Single Judge / Bench, who has decided any Bail matter (including Suspension of Sentences) arising out of any particular FIR (Crime number & Police Station), is not available for any reason, such as on account of change of the Roster / Assignment, sitting in Division Bench, all such subsequent bail applications arising out of same FIR (Crime number & Police Station), shall be listed before the Regular Bench as per current Roster / Assignment or as directed by Hon'ble the Acting Chief Justice.
16. If any Hon'ble Single Judge / Bench, who has decided any Criminal matter arising out of any particular FIR (Crime number & Police Station), is not available for any reason, such as on account of change of Roster / Assignment, sitting in Division Bench, all such subsequent Criminal matters arising out of same FIR (Crime number & Police Station), shall be listed before the Regular Bench, as per current Roster / Assignment or as directed by Hon'ble the Acting Chief Justice.
17. When any companion Hon'ble Judge of any Division Bench is not available for any reason, available junior most Hon'ble Judge will sit in that Division Bench for hearing the matters assigned to that Division Bench. Thereafter, the Hon'ble Judge will sit in his respective Single Bench subject to Division Bench work.
18. When D.B.-I / D.B.-II / D.B.-III / D.B.-IV is not functioning due to non availability of senior Hon'ble Judge, mandatory cases of that D.B. which is not functioning shall be listed before D.B.-II, D.B.-III, D.B.-IV & D.B.-III respectively.
19. If for any reason D.B.-II, D.B.-III & D.B.-IV are not functioning, the mandatory cases of these D.Bs. shall be listed before D.B.-I.
20. All Category DB matters, which are not listable before D.B.-I / D.B.-II / D.B.-III / D.B.-IV for any reason, shall be listed before D.B.-II, D.B.-III, D.B.-IV & D.B.-III respectively.
21. Tied up Writ & Civil matters, which are to be listed before Special Division Benches, will be listed before the Regular / Special Division Bench headed by the Senior Hon'ble Judge of that tied up Division Bench.

22. Single Bench matters, pertaining to Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, in which Fixed Date is given or Mention Memo is allowed and other such matters, which are not listable before the nominated Bench for any reason, such matters will be listed before the available Senior Bench, to whom the Criminal Matters have been assigned.
23. When any Single Bench is not available for any reason, mandatory cases listed before that Single Bench shall be listed before the Bench(es) having same Roster.
24. If, all the Single Benches, to whom any class of cases are assigned, are not available for any reason, then such mandatory class of cases shall be listed before the Senior most available Single Bench.
25. Single Bench matters, which are specially assigned to any Single Bench and the same are not listable before that Bench for any reasons, then such matters shall be listed before the available senior Single Bench.
26. If cases arising out of same Crime number and Police Station have been decided by two different Benches, then fresh matter arising out of same Crime number shall be listed before the Bench, who has decided the matter first, if having same Roster. If cases arising out of same Crime number and Police Station have been decided by two different Benches on the same day, then fresh matter arising out of same Crime number shall be listed before the Senior Bench out of the two Benches, if having same Roster.
27. If any tied-up Writ & Civil Division Bench matter is not listable for any reason before any of the members of that Division Bench, then it shall be listed before any regular Division Bench or Special Division Bench comprising one available member of that Division Bench and any other Senior Judge.
28. If any Single Bench, to whom Criminal matters are assigned, is not available for any reason, matters, which are tied-up with that Single Bench and in which fixed date have been given or Mention Memo(s) have been allowed, shall be listed before the available senior Single Bench having same Roster.
29. Any matter which is not covered by the above note will be complied with in terms of the direction of Hon'ble the Acting Chief Justice.

30. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Roster / Assignment, any matter / case may be listed before any Bench as per direction of Hon'ble the Acting Chief Justice.
