Please refer to your application dt. 07.04.2022 received vide Inward No. 1429 dated 04.05.2022 & registered at our I.D. No. 28/2022-2023 dt. 04.05.2022 (Addressed to the Deputy Registrar, State Public Information Officer (Indore Bench) Speed Post envelope No. EU709916500IN sent by you) regarding supply of information under Right to Information Act, 2005 As per the Application and as desired by you, the information can not be supplied due to the following reason :-

1. The competent Authority of High Court of M.P. has framed 'High Court of M.P. (Right to Information) Rules 2006' under Section 28(1) of the Right to Information Act, 2005. In accordance with the provisions of Rule 7(1) of the said Rules 2006, a citizen/applicant is required to pay fee of Rs. 50/- in the form of non-judicial stamp or Treasury Challan, pasted with self-attested photograph (in original) of the applicant on Form 'A' and you have not filed the application in form no. A and failed to attest your photograph on it, instead you send e-Stamp hence failed to furnish the same, therefore your application can not be entertained.
2. Instead of filing the application in Form No. A and attesting your photograph you have sent the application on Letter Head of the firm Perfexio Legal, Attorneys-At-Law,9655, Sector-C, Pocket-9,Vasant Kunj, NEW DELHI-110070, whereas as per Right to Information Act the person who apply for information should be a citizen. A Company, and association of persons and trust are not citizens as per the Constitution, an executive of a Company or office bearer of an organization can apply for information in his personal capacity.



As per Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005, you may file an appeal to the Appellate Authority (Principal Registrar, High Court of M.P., Indore Bench) within 30 days of the issue of this order.
