3.	What is the use of 1 reader and 2 antenna.	The vendor has to offer best solution for RFID project with 1 reader and 2 antennas, but the vendor can get / quote better technology.
4.	Can you please share us the clarifications to move further and bid for the same. Apart from attached questionnaire in tender document you are given some score in technical bid for Quality certifications (ISO 9001) / CMMi Certifications. Please let us know quality certifications are mandatory to bid the tender or without having CMMi we can offer for this?	During evaluation the technical score shall be deducted accordingly by the High Court for not having the relevant certifications /
5	Is asset tracking system supposed to trace Fixed Asset types or it is supposed to trace inventories as well (like store consumables)?	Asset Tracking is for fixed assets / movable assets but not consumable items.
6	Does the vendor need to consider outdoor assets under metallic/non-metallic asset category? If so, what percentage/quantity shall be proportionated under this category?	All the assets which are available within the Court premises / Rooms shall be considered.

7	Is vendor supposed to extend professional service support to label (tag RFID) existing assets at court premise?	Yes.
8	Does the file tracking system supposed to be integrated with existing Case Management System, if any, for fetching Case Registration details or the proposed system should allow separate registration?
