ORDER

- 1] They are heard and perused the case diary.
- 2] This is the applicant's first bail application filed under Section 483 of *Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita*, 2023/ Section 439 of Cr.P.C. as he is implicated in connection with Crime No.505/2025 registered at Police Station Barwani, District- Barwani (MP) for offence punishable under Sections 137(2), 87, 64(2)(M), 65(1) & 127(3) of B.N.S., 2023 and Sections 3/4 and 5-L/6 of POCSO Act. The applicant is in custody since 13.07.2025.
 - 3] The allegation against the applicant is of abduction and rape.
- 4] Counsel has submitted that the prosecutrix has resided with the applicant for around 7 days, and even in her statement recorded under Section 183 of B.N.S.S. she has stated that she was a consenting party. It is also submitted that her age is also disputed. Thus, it is prayed that the application be allowed.

- 5] Counsel for the State has opposed the prayer.
- 6] Having considered the rival submissions, perusal of the case-diary and the statement of the prosecutrix recorded under Section 183 of B.N.S.S., and the fact that she has resided with the applicant for around 7 days, her age is also disputed, this Court is inclined to allow the present application.
- 7] Accordingly, without commenting on the merits of the case, the application filed by the applicant is hereby **allowed**. The applicant is directed to be released on bail upon furnishing a personal bond in the sum of **Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand)** with one solvent surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court for his/her regular appearance before the trial Court during trial with a condition that he / she shall remain present before the court concerned during trial and shall also abide by the conditions enumerated under Section 437 (3) Criminal Procedure Code, 1973.
 - 8] Accordingly, the application is **allowed** and **disposed of**. C.c. as per rules.
