#### <u>ORDER</u>

- 1. Heard on the question of admission.
- 2. This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Article 226 of the Constitution of India against the order dated 17.06.2025 (Anneuure P/1) passed by respondent No.2 whereby, the petitioner has been transferred from GHS Khedi Khurd, Block Gogawan, District Khargone to M.S. Kotbeda, Block Jhiranya, District Khargone.
- 3. It is submitted that the respondents/competent authority be directed to decide the petitioner's representation and till then the petitioner may be allowed to continue at the present place of posting i.e., GHS Khedi Khurd, Block Gogawan, District Khargone.
- 4. Counsel for the State, on the other hand, has submitted that the representation of the petitioner shall be decided in accordance with law.
- 5. Having considered the rival submissions and on perusal of the documents filed on record, this Court is inclined to dispose off this petition

with a direction to the petitioner to file a fresh representation along with all relevant documents before the competent authority/respondent No.2 within a period of one week from today and if such a representation is filed by the petitioner, the same shall be decided by the competent authority/respondent No.2 by a speaking and reasoned order, in accordance with law within a further period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

- 6. It is made clear that this Court has not reflected upon the merits of the case.
  - 7. With the aforesaid, present petition stands disposed off.
