This is first bail application under Section 439 of Cr.P.C for offence under Section 34(2) of the Excise Act in connection with Crime No.355/2019 registered at Police Station Madhav Nagar, District Katni.

Learned counsel for applicant contends that applicant is in custody since 4.5.2019. The offence is triable by Judicial Magistrate First Class. Sentence for the offence is neither capital punishment nor life imprisonment. Considering the aforesaid, prayer is made to enlarge the applicant on bail.

Learned Panel Lawyer for the State opposes the prayer for grant of bail to the applicant.

On due consideration of the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court deems it proper to grant bail to the applicant. The application is, therefore, allowed and it is directed that applicant Rohit Choudhary be released on bail on his furnishing a personal bond in sum of Rs.40000/-with a solvent surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of JMFC concerned or CJM for his appearance in Trial Court on the dates so fixed by that Court during trial. It is directed that applicant shall comply with the provisions of Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.

Accordingly, this bail application stands allowed & disposed of. Certified copy as per rules.
